Qualifying shows:
September & October

ODS Provincial teams will be selected consisting of 3 - 9 riders.
Only one rider per dressage level will earn a spot in the provincial team
(Lead Rein; Special Test; Walk & Trot; Pony Prelim; Pony Novice;
Pony Elementary; J & A Prelim; J & A Novice; J & A Elementary)



To be eligible for team selection the horse-rider combination must participate in both the September & October shows at the same level in the qualifying class.

Riders will earn an aggregate score for the qualifying rounds ridden in the September and October shows. The rider with the highest aggregate for the level will earn the spot in their provincial team and then go on to represent their province in the Battle of the Provinces in November.

Here, riders will ride one test each and a team aggregate will be calculated. This aggregate will determine the ultimate champion province of 2021

Riders that are not selected for an ODS team, may form an Open Team in the same format, however these combinations are only required to participate in one qualifying show and do not need to be the highest scoring pair. These teams may only consist of one rider per level and will need to select a Team Representative and mascot character. These teams may also participate in the Battle of the Provinces in November.

1. Mix 150ml Ecologic in a 750ml spray bottle with water
2. Apply liberally to the contaminated area on the fabric you need to clean.
3. Agitate with a soft brush – firm enough to agitate the dirt, soft enough to not harm the fabric.
4. Repeat this on the opposite side of the fabric as well.
5. Wash normally as per washing machine or hand wash.

Shedding season is upon us, but have no fear, we are here!



Your horse has spent the whole autumn and winter building up a long and thick coat to keep him warm in the parts experiencing snow (but also those in the parts where most people have their fingers crossed for snow, but only experience icy winds). However now that the daylight hours are getting longer and the temperatures are rising with the coming of spring, that thick coat wants to be shed.

Tip no 1

CONSISTENT GROOMING

Using a currycomb is advisable for it grabs the loose hair better and makes the whole process of removing hair, considerably more time efficient and affective.

Daily grooming is not only necessary for keeping the coat and hooves healthy and maintained, it is also crucial to take that time to examine your horse for any injuries or abnormalities. This way, serious illness and unnecessary vet bills can be avoided.

Tip no 3

VACUUM TIME!

Getting out that vacuum and sucking up all that hair is perfect! First ensure your horse is comfortable with the loud noise of the vacuum.

Slowly introduce the suctioning and sounds and don't let your horse stress, after all it's supposed to be a fun, learning experience for both you and your horse. Do not force it.

Tip no 2

BATHING

Shedding can be urged on by a good old scrub-a-dub-dub with lots of bubbles.

In the process, the follicles are loosened up and dead skin cells are removed, leaving your horse looking and smelling amazing... and a lot less fuzzy and furry!

Tip no 4

REGULAR DEWORMING

Deworming is an essential part of health care and gives a sheen to the coat.

Usually a coat of dull hairs sticking on end is an indication of a horse that is due for deworming.

Remember to use a variety of dewormers through the year as this prevents that the parasites develop a resistance.

Consult your veterinarian for advice.

PRO TIP

Never, EVER wear lip gloss when you are brushing your horse during the shedding season!

Wearing the right types of clothes will make your life so much better.

Decide on clothes that hair can be removed from easily and stay away from fluffy fleeces.
